#### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

1. GOEL INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY AND MANAGEMENT LUCKNOW is organising Three Days Zonal Level Sports Competitions for Lucknow Zone on behalf of Dr. A.P.J. Abdul KalamTechnical University Lucknow (Refer Letter No. डॉ॰ए॰पी॰जे॰अ॰क॰प्रा॰वि॰/डीन/डी एस डब्लू - 1/2017/5976-76) dated 01/11/2017.

The competitions will be conducted in the GITM Campus under GITM, LUCKNOW(360) from 23<sup>rd</sup> Jan to 25 <sup>th</sup> Jan 2018.

**2.** The competitions will be conducted in accordance with the rules of "**Sports Authority of India**" and **Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Technical University** Lucknow as updated from time to time.

#### **Competitions**

- **3.** Following competitions will be conducted:-
- (a) Indoor Games
- (i) Table Tennis Singles: Male/Female (2 Participants M, 2 Participants F).
- (ii) Table Tennis Doubles: Male/Female (4 Participants M, 4 Participants F)
- (iii) Chess Male/Female (2 Participants M, 2 Participants F).

## (b) Outdoor Games

- (i) Badminton (4 Participants M, 4 Participants F)
- (ii) Volley Ball Male/ Female (10 Participants M, 10 Participants F).
- (iii) Basket Ball Male/Female (10 Participants M,10 Participants F)
- (iv) Football (14 M)
- **(b) Athletics.** (15 Participants M,15 Participants F)
- (i) 100 Mtr. Race -Boys & Girls.
- (ii) 200 Mtr. Race-Boys & Girls.
- (iii) 400 Mtr. Race-Boys & Girls.
- (iv) 800 Mtr. Race Boys & Girls.
- (v) 4 X 100 Mtr. Relay Race-Boys & Girls.
- (vi) 4 X 400 Mtr. Relay Race-Boys & Girls
- (vii) Long Jump. Boys & Girls.
- (viii) High Jump. Boys & Girls.
- (viii) Javelin Throw. Boys & Girls.

## **Rules**

- 4. General Rules. Rules of the Competition are as follows:-
- (a) All the participants and volunteers are requested to get a "No Objection Certificate" from the respective principal/teacher- in charge, which should enlist the names of all the participants who have been selected to respective college.
- **(b)** The names of the participants for each competition should be written on separate A4 sheet (competition wise) apart from the NOC, for registration purposes.
- (c) It is compulsory for the all the participants, volunteers to get their **college Identity Card/ I.D. proof**. The participants have to wear the I.D. cards distributed by the **host college (GITM, LUCKNOW) at all times.**
- **(d)** Participants are expected to carry their own kit which they intend to use for their respective Sports Events.
- **(e)** Each college has to provide the host college (**GITM**, **LUCKNOW**) with a "Point of Contact."
- **(f)** Participants of all the competitions are requested to report 30 minutes prior to the start of their respective events at the assigned venues.
- **(g)** All the colleges are expected to report with the respective participants of the above mentioned competitions at the time of registration.
- (h) Each team can bring five extra members (cheering team/ helpers).
- (i) The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
- (j) All the teams should be in **proper sports kit**.
- (k) A "refundable security deposit" of Rs. 1000 will please be deposited by each team which will be refunded after adjusting the cost of damages, if any, at the end of Competition.
- (1) If a team manager wishes to lodge a protest at end of the match/event, then, such a protest must be lodged in writing and handed to the Org. Secretary on duty within 10 minutes of the completion of the match.
- (m) Medical/Physiotherapist will be provided by the GITM, Lucknow.
- (n) All decisions of the umpires shall be final in case of any indiscipline on the court or anywhere in the college may result in the disqualification of the individual or teams.
- (o) The schedule and fixtures will be mailed to the colleges.
- **(p)** Colleges are requested to confirm their participation/ registration for all events by 15th January 2018.

- **5. Appeal and Technical Committee**. A Committee will be formed for conduct of each event successfully. The committee will be guided by the rules in vogue regarding conduct of each event. The decision of Appeal and Technical Committee will be final.
- **6**. **Prize Distribution**. Names of the winners of each event will be announced immediately on completion of the event. Prize distribution will be held on 25<sup>th</sup> January, 2018 at Goelplex, Goel Campus, Lucknow.

# Appendix "A"

### (Refers to Para 7 of General Instructions)

#### **RULES**

#### 1. Athletics.

Boys and Girls. Following events will be conducted:-

- (i) Heat will be conducted for 100m, 200m, 400m, and 800m races. Heats will be followed by the finals.
- (ii) Heat will be conducted for 4x100, 400mx400 races. Heats will be followed by the finals.
- (iii) All other races, throws and jumps will have finals. Results would be based on the best performance.
- (iv) Max No of Team Member: 15 Male/ 15 Female will participate from each Institution.

#### 2. Basketball (Boys and Girls)

#### **RULES**

- (i) FIBA rules will apply.
- (ii) 10 minutes each quarter with 2 min break between the quarters and 5 minutes at half time.
- (iii) Teams should report to the Basket Ball court half an hour before commencement of the match.
- (iv) All the players of the team should have same colour of jersey with printed numbers.
- (v) Maximum 10 players are allowed in a team.

#### 3. Football

#### **RULES**

- (i) FIFA rules will apply.
- (ii) Maximum number of participants in a team will be 14 including extras.
- (iii) Teams should report to the Football ground half an hour before commencement of the match.
- (iv) All the players of the team should have same colour of jersey with printed numbers.

#### 4. Chess.

- (a) Events: Classical (mixed).
- (b) Rules:
- (i) Limit on numbers of players:
- (ii) Classical: 2 Person Male/Female from each Institution

- 5. Table Tennis.
- (a) Rules Boys Team.
- (i) **Format of Play:** Singles (A vs X), singles (B vs Y), doubles and reverse singles (A vs Y & B vs X).
- (ii) All games will be best of five.
- (iii) Players paying singles will not be allowed to repeat in doubles.
- (iv) Max Participants allowed per College: Four boys and Four girls.
- (b) Rules Girls Team.
- (i) **Format of Play**: Single (A vs X), singles (B vs Y), doubles and reverse singles (A vs Y & B vs X).
- (ii) All games would be best of four.
- 6. Volley Ball.
- (a) Rules
- (i) Maximum No. of Players- 10(girls & boys)
- (ii) **Type of Tournament** League, Pool or knockout depending on the number of teams.
- **7. Organizing Committee.** Organizing Committee will be nominated by "GITM" for the conduct of each event once the actual participation of Institutions is known.
